## Context Assessment Index (CAI)

### *Tool's Purpose*

The Context Assessment Index (CAI) assesses the context in which care is provided and the readiness of this context to implement evidence into practice (McCormack et al., 2009).

### *Brief Tool Description*

- 37 items scored on a 4-point Likert scale. Three elements:
  - Culture (16 items)
  - Leadership (7 items)
  - Evaluation (14 items)

### *Knowledge to Action Framework Phase(s):*

- Assess barriers/facilitators to knowledge use
- Monitor knowledge use
