





Implementation Climate Scale (ICS)

Tool's Purpose

The Implementation Climate Scale (ICS) measures employees' shared perceptions regarding the importance of implementing and using EBP, and the components of the organizational context that are indicative of a supportive organizational environment that prioritizes and values EBP (Ehrhart et al., 2014).

Brief Tool Description

- 18 items, 5-point Likert scores. Six Dimensions:
 - o Focus on evidence-based practices (EBP) (3 items)
 - Educational support for EBP (3 items)
 - o Recognition for EBP (3 items)
 - Rewards for EBP (3 items)
 - Selection for EBP (3 items)
 - Selection for openness (3 items)

Knowledge to Action Framework Phase(s):

- Assess barriers/facilitators to knowledge use
- Monitor knowledge use
