





Revised Professional Practice Environment (RPPE)

Tool's Purpose

The Revised Professional Practice Environment (RPPE) is a multidimensional measure of clinicians' perceptions of their practice environment based on five elements that are predictive of Magnet hospital status (i.e., transformational leadership, structural empowerment, exemplary professional practice, new knowledge, innovations and improvements, and empirical outcomes) (Erikson et al., 2009).

Brief Tool Description

- 39 items scored using a 4- point Likert scale. Eight components:
 - Handling disagreement and conflict (9 items)
 - Leadership and autonomy in clinical practice (5 items)
 - Internal work motivation (8 items)
 - o Control over practice (5 items)
 - Teamwork (4 items)
 - Communication about patient (3 items)
 - Cultural sensitivity (3 items)
 - Staff relationships with physicians (2 items)

Knowledge to Action Framework Phase(s):

- Assess barriers/facilitators to knowledge use
- Monitor knowledge use
