





"Nursing is the central pillar of a well-functioning health system. Enduring the hardships of a 22-month pandemic has turned an existing shortage – thanks to Bill 124 – into an RN workforce crisis."

Repeal Bill 124

Ontario is in a nursing human resource crisis that has been made worse by Bill 124 and the COVID-19 pandemic. Nurses are leaving their workplaces and at times the province or the profession altogether. This has a direct impact on patient safety and the effectiveness of Ontario's health system.

Enacted into law in 2019, Bill 124 limits wage increases to one per cent per year, which is lower than inflation. On Dec. 7 RNAO called on MPPs to stand with nurses and demand Premier Ford repeal Bill 124.


