Provincial decision not to reopen schools

RNAO recommends that the government immediately take the following actions:

- 1. Prepare schools for a safe reopening in September, with investments in ventilation, required renovations to avoid crowded classrooms, and full vaccination of all staff and children 12 and older.
- 2. Provide substantial **investments in supports for disadvantaged children**, special education and mental health programs.
- 3. Provide permanent funding for the 625 public health registered nurses assigned to support schools.
- 4. Provide funding subsidies for outdoor camps and other outdoor recreational activities for children whose families can't afford to pay. Encourage kids, including those who may not have the financial means, to safely participate in summer activities as an effective response to the mental health stress that is affecting so many children.
