

We need breakneck delivery timelines as--without PPE and ventilators --Canadians and healthcare workers' lives are on the line. Employers and staff need timelines

RNAO Advocacy: Urgent steps for Government

- Prepare for 'worst-case scenario'
- Honest and transparent communication
- Universal PPE for all sectors
- Expand testing contact tracing and self isolation
- Shut down movement in the streets
- Strengthen Telehealth-monitor wait times
- Take care of health workers-physical & mental health



RNAO Advocacy: Urgent steps for Government

- Masks for ALL those facing patients
- Urgent and massive procurement of PPE
- Hospitals: Scale up fast. Be ready for avalanche of patients
- Separate patients & separate staff
- Expand ICU beds, ventilators, ICU staff
- Attend to critical care of non-COVID-19 patients
- Prioritize vulnerable populations and workers: LTC, shelters & correctional facilities
- Massive public education and enrollment
- Solidarity


