Guideline Search Strategy

1. Structured Website Search

A member of the RNAO guideline development team (project coordinator) searched an established list of websites for guidelines.

Guidelines were selected based on the following criteria:

- Guideline was in English or French, national and international in scope
- Guideline was published after January 2002
- Guideline was strictly about the topic area: Elder Abuse
- Guideline was evidence-based (e.g., contained references, description of evidence, sources of evidence)
- Guidelines was developed for populations similar to Canada
- Guideline was intended as a clinical best practice guideline or best practice guideline
- Guideline was available and accessible for retrieval

2. Hand Search:

RNAO Expert Panel members were asked to review personal libraries to identify and submit potentially relevant guidelines. Guidelines submitted for consideration by panel members were integrated into the retrieved list of guidelines if they had not been identified by the on-line guideline search and met the inclusion criteria.

Systematic Review Search Strategy

Concurrent with the review of existing guidelines, a systematic review for recent literature relevant to the scope of the guideline was conducted by a health sciences librarian.

Databases Searched: Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health (CINAHL), Cochrane Controlled Trials (CT), Cochrane Systematic Reviews (SR), Database of Abstracts of Reviews of Effectiveness (DARE), Embase, Joanna Briggs Institute, MEDLINE, MEDLINE In progress, Ovid Healthstar, and PsychINFO.

Inclusion Criteria:

- Focus on the topic of Elder Abuse which includes:
 - Screening
 - Assessment
 - Intervention
- Published between January 2000 to April/May 2013
- Age range:
 - o adults: >55 years old
- Published in English or French
- Published in a Peer Reviewed Journal
- Accessible for Retrieval
- Any health setting or sector
- Relevant to the scope of nursing
- All Study Types: Systematic reviews, RCTs, meta-analysis, higher quality qualitative and quantitative research studies.

Exclusion Criteria:

- Dissertations, research protocols, commentaries / letters to the editor, narrative/descriptive papers, lab/pre-clinical studies, incidence/prevalence papers
- Articles ≤ 1 page
- Protocols on Study Designs

Hand Search

Panel members were asked to review personal libraries to identify key articles not found through the above search strategies. Articles identified by panel members were included in the search results if two nursing research associates independently determined the articles had not been identified by the literature search and met the inclusion criteria.
