Dr. Karen Campbell

Karen is a RN, MScN, PhD, and NSWOC who currently is adjunct faculty for the Masters of Clinical Science in Wound Healing at Western University in London, Ontario. As well she is the President for the International Skin Tear Advisory Panel (ISTAP). She has functioned as an advanced practice nurse in geriatrics, wound care and continence.

Karen was the co-chair of the RNAO BPG Assessment and Management of Pressure Injuries for the Interprofessional Team and the national guideline on Pressure Ulcer Prevention and Treatment in the spinal cord injured population. She has been a panel member on the International Skin Tear Advisory Panel and Incontinence Associated Dermatitis International Best Practice Principles. Karen has a strong interest in skin health and frequently speaks and publishes on this topic.



Dr. Laura Teague

Laura is a Nurse Practitioner, Clinical and Academic lead for wound care at the Sinai Health System in Toronto, Ontario. From 1987 to 2016, Laura worked in various clinical and leadership positions as a registered nurse, clinical nurse specialist and nurse practitioner - wound care at St. Michael's Hospital. She has been directly involved with the development of best practice guidelines through the RNAO. Laura has provided continuous leadership through the development of the Ontario Wound Care Interest Group as the founding president and membership on the executive. Laura recently defended her PhD thesis at McMaster University, Faculty of Health Sciences, School of Nursing. Her research involved a cohort study of spinal cord injured persons who have undergone surgical closure for pressure injuries. This funded study involves cost, health care utilization and predictors of complications in this population. Most recently, Health Quality Ontario invited Laura to be an expert panel co-chair for the development of quality standards for three types of wounds.
